1. All candidates are required to provide a copy of their birth certificate. The 'long' version for British births. For naturalised British subjects a copy of their naturalisation papers will be required.
2. Candidates must be able to satisfy the Court that they are directly concerned with, or interested in, the craft of scientific instrumentation
3. Candidates should completed the form in block letters in ink
4. Occupation - please enter here the title you wish to be used e.g. Instrument Maker, Scientist, Chartered Engineer....
5. Position - please enter here your current job title
6. Candidates must be aware of the financial implications as given in the table below
